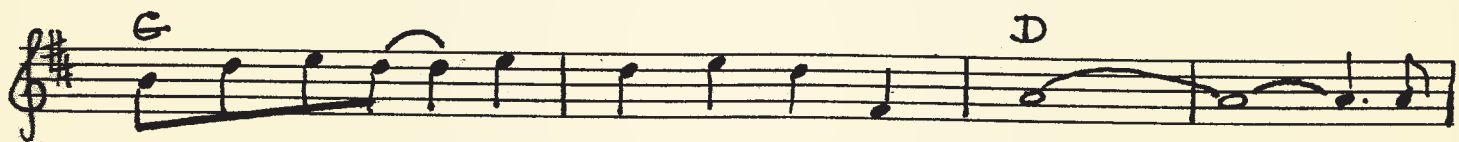

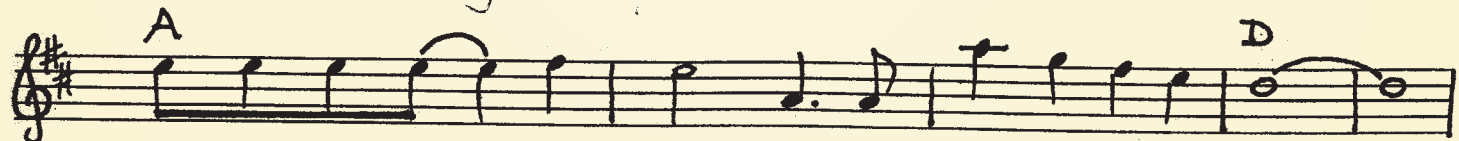
Two lit-tle kids play-ing down by a stream

Down at the muddy bank we'll have some fun



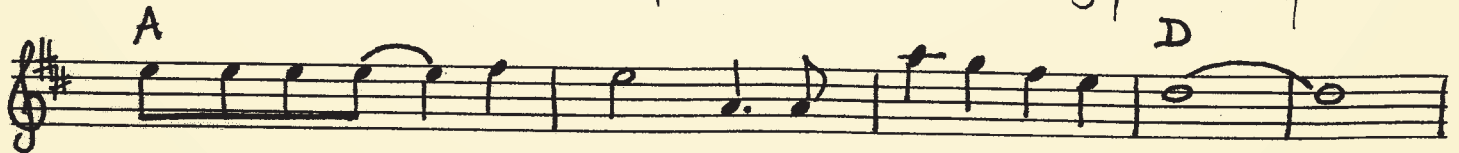
one finds a fea-ther the oth-er picks up a leaf
